

# Brownie Girl Scout Workshops Spring 2010

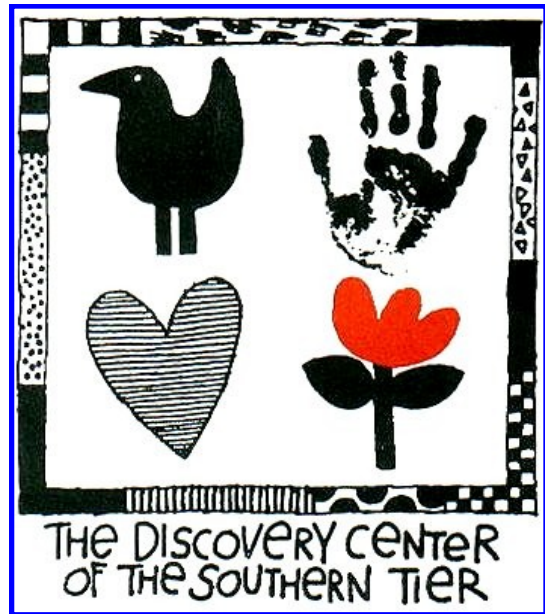
## March Workshops
